She informed that as per the guidelines issued by Ministry of Women and Child Development, all the organizations having more than 10 personnel/officials must constitute an ICC and, in this context, this committee has been set in place by CRCE. She described the role of ICC and welcomed suggestions from all members to make it effective.
- 5. The Committee noted that <u>no complaint of sexual harassment has been received</u> from any woman employee of this College until now. It was emphasized that in order to create awareness and continuous sensitization among the employees, it is essential to place banners/posters/notices defining sexual harassment at prominent places in the CRCE campus.
- 6. The committee had discussions at length and the following suggestions were made:
 - (i) The Handbook on Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace, (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013 issued by Ministry of Women and Child Development and the composition of the Internal Complaints Committee of CRCE be uploaded on CRCE's website.
 - (ii) All agreed to the fact that an awareness about, Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013 along with the latest order of the online management system titled "Sexual Harassment Electronic-Box (SHe-Box)" for registering complaints by female employees as well as girl students of the College, must be created to prevent instances of harassment of women employees in future also.

- (iii) A complaint Drop box must be placed in the office premises and/ or Email-id should be displayed for registering the complaints.
- The Chairperson conveyed her thanks to the members for attending the meeting and the members agreed that the Committee will meet next year or earlier, if need arise. Next meeting of the Committee will be held in the month of March, 2023.
